Things to do in area

The Nut, Tasmania's iconic volcanic plug, offers stunning panoramic views of Stanley and surrounding landscapes. Reach the summit via a steep 10-20 minute walk or a 5-minute chairlift ride (closed in winter) that ascends 95 metres to over 250 metres. Remember to check weather conditions before your visit and note that a fee applies for the chairlift experience.

Stanley's main street is a delightful journey through time, characterised by beautifully preserved historic buildings that narrate tales from the town's vibrant past. Ramble through the shops and cafes. Follow the Stanley Heritage Walk, a self-quided walk that explores the history, architecture and culture of this diverse village. - Quiet Time: Please keep noise to a minimum between 9:00pm and 9:00am.
- Children: Please provide adequate supervision for your children at all times.

- **Parking**: Each cabin or site has provision for the parking of 1 vehicle only.
- Pets: We welcome pets on certain sites only. Pets are not permitted near the beachfront sites due to penguin habitats, or in Park cabins and buildings (other than registered guide dogs).
- Day Visitors: Park in Visitors car parking area only.
- Garbage: Wrap all garbage in bags and place in outside bins.
- Camp Fires: Fires are not permitted in the Park.
